Dear Mr. K.

At its hearing on May 12, 1982, the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That in or about April, 1981, vou did falsify an academic record of the University of Toronto, namely your transcript from the Department of Civil Engineering and your transcript from the Faculty of Management Studies, and you did attempt to utter or make use of such falsified records for the purpose of obtaining letters of reference in connection with an application for a Cadillac Fairview Housing Fellowship to the University of Toronto contrary to Section E.1(c) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.

The Tribunal found you guilty of the charge and imposed the following sanctions:

That you be censured and that the censure be recorded on your academic record for a period of one year beginning in May, 1982.

In giving their reasons for this sanction, the jury cited mitigating circumstances and also stated that you had suffered over the past year as a result of this impending charge.

I am forwarding to you and to the University Discipline Counsel information regarding rights of appeal. The deadline for you or for the University to file an appeal is June 7, 1982.
