Dear Mr. M.

On November 28, 1983 the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charges against you:

(1) that on or about June 29, 1983 you did utter or make use of a falsified academic record of the University of Toronto contrary to s.E(1)(c) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.

The following are the particulars:

vou did forward to the Ontario University Application Centre in Guelph in a University of Toronto envelope a falsified copy of your University of Toronto official transcript, for use as part of your medical school application.

(2) that on or about July 25, 1983, you did utter or make use of a falsified academic record of the University of Toronto contrary to s.E(1)(c) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.

The following are the particulars:

you did forward to the Ontario University Application Centre in Guelph, upon request, a second falsified copy of your University of Toronto official transcript in a University of Toronto envelope, which purported to eminate from the University of Toronto.

I am writing to formally advise you of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to these charges. The jury found you to be guilty of both charges and recommended that the following sanctions be imposed:

- · that you be expelled from the University of Toronto
- that the expulsion be recorded permanently on your academic transcript.

The jury provided the following reasons for these sanctions:

'The decision to recommend the most serious sanction of expulsion is being taken because of the most severe nature of the charge and the fact that it occurred twice. It is necessary to set an example to other members of this community, and also to maintain the integrity of this. University's credentials as a degree-issuing educational institution.'

I am enclosing information regarding rights of appeal. The deadline for you to file an appeal is December 21, 1983.
