Dear Mr. L.

At its hearing on July 13th, 1987 the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That on April 13th, 1987 you did personate Mr. V at his final examination in the course APS 1008 (S.LO 101) contrary to Section E.1(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour. At the final examination in the course APS 1008 on April 13th, 1987, you signed the attendance list as Mr. V and the exam paper you submitted purported to be an exam paper written by Mr. V.

The jury accepted your plea of guilty to the charge and imposed the following sanctions:

That you be suspended from the University of Toronto for two years, from September 1st, 1987 to August 31st, 1989;

That the suspension be recorded on your transcript for five years, from July 13th, 1987 to July 12th, 1992.

The jury gave the following reasons for this decision: "we are more lenient [than the University] in this case because: 1. We feel that Mr. L. did not initiate this incident; 2. We think that two years suspension is sufficiently appropriate to impress upon him the seriousness of his action; and 3. because of the gravity of the offence, we wish this to be recorded on his transcript as a deterrent."

Information concerning rights of appeal may be found in Section L of the Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The deadline for filing an appeal by you or by the University is August 7th, 1987.
