Appointment of a Vice-President and Principal, University of

On June 30, 2015 Professor Hargurdeep (Deep) Saini will be completing his first term as Vice-President and Principal, University of Toronto Mississauga. Professor Saini is eligible for reappointment.

In accordance with Section 62 (b) of the *Policy on Appointment of Academic Administrators*, we are writing to call for nominations of individuals to serve on the committee that will advise on the appointment of a Vice-President and Principal. The Committee's first task will be to undertake a review and advise me on priorities that should be considered for the Vice-President and Principal. Given that Professor Saini is eligible to be re-appointed, the Committee will also consider whether to recommend reappointment or to proceed with a search.

The *Policy on Appointment of Academic Administrators* mandates the potential composition of the advisory committee as follows:

- The President (Co-Chair);
- The Vice-President and Provost (Co-Chair);
- The Dean of the School of Graduate Studies or representative;
- Three to five members of the teaching staff of the campus;
- One to three students of the campus;
- A librarian, where appropriate;

- Two or three other qualified scholars from within or outside this University, but outside the campus;
- In addition, the committee may include an alumnus/a, a member of the administrative staff, and a qualified individual from outside the University.

Mr. Louis Charpentier, Secretary of the Governing Council, will serve as secretary to the Committee. Ms Sheree Drummond, Deputy Secretary, will also provide support.
