Re: Amendment to Meric S. Gertler June 28, 2013 Contract

During an administrative leadership appointment a faculty member does not accrue research and study leave, and has reduced opportunity for full scholarly engagement. Accordingly, such appointments can provide for administrative leave when the appointment ends, so as to permit an opportunity, where possible, for the faculty member to begin to resume the full range of scholarly activities after the conclusion of the appointment. In the case of the present Contract, there is a provision in section 22(d) for a payment in lieu of and in full satisfaction of earned administrative leave that has not been taken. Any such payment would require the agreement of the Chair and of Gertler.

Having considered the matter, both Gertler and the Chair have agreed that the possibility of a payment in lieu of administrative leave shall be waived. Accordingly, the administrative leave entitlement shall be calculated as provided elsewhere in the Contract, but no payment in lieu shall either be requested or granted, and subsection 22(d) is hereby deleted.
