

# Academic Discipline Process Flowchart At the Decanal/Faculty Level




# Academic Discipline Process Flowchart At the Tribunal Level



# Academic Discipline Process Flowchart Appealing a Tribunal Decision

### Notice of Appeal

Either party has 21 calendar days to appeal the panel's decision on questions that are not of fact alone (ie the party cannot argue facts already mentioned or discussed at the Tribunal) and/or from sanction by filing a Notice of Appeal stating the relief sought (ie what is the outcome the party wishes to achieve) and the grounds of the appeal (ie arguments/reasons used to prove their case). Sanctions are stayed.


