THE MEETING WAS HELD IN CLOSED SESSION

1. Mr. L.

Mr. L-, a student in the Fourth Year in the Department of Architecture appealed against a decision of the Appeals Committee of the Department confirming his failure in the Fourth Year. This was Mr. L3second failure in Architecture and as a result, he was required to withdraw.

Mr. L. presented medical evidence to show that he had been in ill-health during the spring of 1975 and that because of a misunderstanding which caused him to believe his illness to be much more serious than it actually was, he had been under considerable mental strain as well. He requested that he be premitted to enter the Fifth Year on a probationary basis.

While the Subcommittee agreed that Mr. L's illness would have affected his performance during March and April 1975, it could not conclude that but for this he would have successfully completed the year.

After consideration of the documentary and oral evidence,

YOUR SUBCOMMITTEE AGREED

THAT the appeal of Mr. L. against a decision of the Appeals Committee of the Department of Architecture be denied.

In conveying this decision to Mr. L., it was pointed out to him that he might petition the Department of Architecture to be allowed to repeat the Fourth Year.
