#### Mrs. K. - 19-14

Mrs. K, a part-time student in Extension, appealed to be granted aegrotat consideration in a financial accounting course, COMAOLYN, at Scarborough College. Mrs. K, had been unable to attend the final examination and petitioned that she be given full credit for the course without further evaluation, in view of the quality of her term work.

In an alternative supplement to the petition, the appellant requested that should the Subcommittee not allow the appeal for acgrotat standing, and that, in view of the brevity of time left in which Mrs. K. could prepare for the mid-August final examination, she and her lecturer be directed to work out a mutually satisfactory arrangement for final evaluation to be approved by Dean King.

After consideration of the documentary and oral evidence,

YOUR SUBCOMMITTEE. AGREED

- (1) THAT the appeal of Mrs. K. for aegrotat consideration in COMAOLYN be denied, and
- (2) THAT in view of extenuating circumstances related to timing of the appeal, Mrs. K. be offered the option of undertaking either of the following to obtain final evaluation in COMAOlYN:
  - a) To write the regular August examination, without fee, as previously decided by the Committee on Standing, or
  - b) To write a special examination in this course to be arranged by Scarborough College, at a time convenient to both the College and Mrs. K.

The meeting adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
