At its hearing on Thursday, July 5, 1979 the Senior Branch of the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

that in the final year examination in Gross Anatomy on Monday, April 30, 1979 you committed an offence under the Code of Behaviour, Sections E.1(a) and G.7.

I am writing to advise you of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to this charge. The jury found you to be guilty of the charge under Section E.1(a) and imposed the following sanction under the Code of Behaviour:

Sanction F.1(c) - assignment of a mark of zero in the final examination for Gross Anatomy.

The jury further specified, in accordance with Section G.4 of the Code, that this sanction was to be recorded on your academic record for a period of two years.

In accordance with Rule 65 I enclose extracts from the Enactment and Rules of Procedure regarding rights of appeal and the time limit in which the appeal must be filed.
