At its hearing on Wednesday, October 3, 1979 the Local Branch of the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That you used unauthorized aids in Economics 333Y (summer session) Term Test held on 5th July, 1979, from 7:00 - 9:00 p.m. and that you resubmitted your answer paper for reassessment after changing an answer. This is contrary to section E.1(a) (i) (ii), G.1, G.6(a) (i), (iv), (b), G.7 of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour (Revised and Approved).

I am writing to formally advise you of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to this charge. As a result of the jury's decision you were acquitted of the charge.

In accordance with #65 of the Rules of Procedure I am sending to each of the parties to the proceedings information regarding rights of appeal and the time limit in which an appeal must be filed.
