At the hearing on Tuesday, December 18, 1979 the Local Branch of the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charges against you -

- you are hereby charged under Section E.1. (a) (i) and Section G.6. (a) (iv) and G.6. (a) (v) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters in that on November 14, 1979, you knowingly obtained unauthorised assistance in a mid-term examination for MATA22Y held at Scarborough College, in that the examination paper submitted under your name was written by someone other than yourself.
- you are also charged under Section E.1 (a) (ii) and Sections G.6. (a) (iv) and G.6 (a) (v) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters in that on November 14, 1979 in a mid-term examination for MATA22Y held at Scarborough College, you knowingly represented as your own work what was in fact the work of another, in that the examination paper submitted under your name for credit was written by someone other than yourself.

I am writing to formally advise you of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to the charges to which you pleaded guilty. The jury, by majority vote, recommended that you be assigned a mark of zero in the mid-term examination for MATA22Y
