At the hearing on Wednesday, February 27, 1980 the Local Branch of the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

- that you did on December 10, 1979 in an examination in JMPB50F held at Scarborough College knowingly copy the work of another student and submit it as your own work, contrary to Section E.1(a)(i) and Section E.1(a)(ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.

I am writing to formally advise you of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to the charge to which you pleaded guilty.

- the jury ordered that the following sanctions be imposed:
  - i) that you be assigned a mark of zero in the December 10, 1979 examination in JMPB50F;
  - ii) that the Principal of Scarborough College write a formal letter of censure to you; and
  - iii) that reference to this academic offence be recorded on your academic transcript for a period of one year, the reference to be removed from your transcript on February 27, 1981.

• the jury provided the following reasons for the sanctions it selected:

- i) as you had been found guilty of the charge it was appropriate that you receive no credit on the examination in question;
- ii) that a mark of zero was an inadequate penalty; and
- iii) that the University of Toronto had a responsibility to provide other educational institutions with a clear and correct indication of a student's academic performance and behaviour.

In accordance with #65 of the Rules of Procedure I am forwarding to you and Associate Dean Warden information regarding appeal rights and procedures. An appeal would have to be filed with the Secretariat on or before March 14, 1980.
