At hearings on October 26 and November 2, 1982 the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charges against you:

1) That on or about April 26, 1982, you did knowingly obtain unauthorized assistance in an academic examination contrary to s.E.1(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour. The following are the particulars:

In the final examination in Psychology 100 you did copy a substantial number of the answers from another student, Mr. Peter Cakuls.

2) That on or about April 26, 1982, you did knowingly represent as your own, in academic work submitted for credit in a course or programme of study, ideas and expressions of ideas of another student. The following are the particulars:

In the final examination of Psychology 100 you did copy a substantial number of the answers from the paper of another student, Mr. * C.

The Tribunal found you not guilty of both charges.

I am forwarding to you and to the University Discipline Counsel Information regardings rights of appeal. The deadline for you or for the University to file an appeal is November 26, 1982.
