Dear Mr. S.

On June 23rd, 1983, the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That on or about September 25, 1981 you did knowingly obtain unauthorized assistance in the writing of an English Proficiency Test, contrary to Section E(1)(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.

I am writing to advise you formally of the decision of the Tribunal with respect to this charge. The jury found you to be guilty and recommended that the following sanctions be imposed:

- . that you be suspended from the University of Toronto for a period of one year beginning September 1, 1983;
- . that this suspension be recorded on your academic transcript until September 1, 1985.

The jury provided the following reasons for these sanctions:

"We the jury find that the offence committed by Mr. S. involving both premeditation and a second party to be particularly serious and needs to be treated as such. While recognising that Mr. S. experienced suffering over the undue delay of the Tribunal, we also recognise that he might have derived certain academic advantages from this delay."

I enclose information concerning rights of appeal. The deadline for you to file an appeal is July 18th, 1983.
