The Appeal Division of the University Tribunal met on November 9, 1983 to consider your appeal from the penalty that was assigned by the University Tribunal at its hearing on September 19, 1983.

It was the decision of the Appellate Tribunal that your appeal be dismissed. The majority decision was that the jury had not committed any error in principle in sentencing, that it had acted in a well-reasoned manner, and that accordingly the appeal should be dismissed. One member of the Appellate Division dissented, indicating that he would have allowed sentence appeal in one respect, namely a reduction in the length of time that the academic misconduct would be noted on the transcript, from August 31, 1989 to November 1, 1986.
