Dear Mr. T.

At its hearing on November 14, 1983 the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That in or about April, 1983, you did submit for credit in ESC499Y, a thesis entitled "A Mathematical Model of an Aircraft Occupant's Crash-Impact Response" in which you knowingly represented as your own the ideas and expressions of ideas of another, contrary to Section E.1(a)(ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.

The Tribunal found you guilty of the charge. Listed below are the sanctions that were imposed together with the jury's reason for each sanction:

- a grade of zero for the thesis
 The thesis was definitely not his own work
- suspension from the university for six months from the date of the hearing

While we full a suspension to be necessary, six number is enough to make the point

no notation to be made on his transcript
 The mark of zero is sufficient.

I am forwarding to you and to the University Discipline Counsel infermation regarding rights of appeal. The deadline for you or for the University to file an appeal is December 6, 1983.
