Dear Mr. R.

At its hearing on October 23rd, 1984, the Trial Division of the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That on or about April 29th, 1983, while a member of the University, you did knowingly submit for credit in the course PHE 402S academic work containing references to sources which had been concocted contrary to Section E 1(a)(iv) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour. The following are the particulars:

On or about April 29th, 1983, you did submit for credit in the PHE 402S a Research Paper based on Leadership Questionnaires which Questionnaires purported to be completed by participants in various recreational activities but which in fact were completed in whole or substantially by yourself.

The Tribunal found you to be guilty of this charge and imposed the following sanctions:

- . A grade of 5% in PHE 402S
- Suspension from the University from January 1, 1985 to December 31, 1986
- A record of the suspension to be recorded on the official transcript until June 1st, 1991.

In assigning these sanctions, the jury noted that they had accepted the University's recommendation. They gave as their reasons the following statement:

As a deterrent to others we considered expulsion as the proper sanction. However, we decided not to go beyond the University's request. The sanctions should not be less than were proposed because there were no extenuating circumstances, this was a repeated offence, and we heard no indication from the accused that he recognized the serious nature of his offence and no committment that he would never do anything like this again.

I am forwarding to you and to the University Discipline Counsel information concerning rights of appeal. The deadline for you or for the University to file an appeal is November 15th, 1984.
