At its hearings on February 25, March 9, March 26 and April 9, 1987, the University Tribunal considered the following charges against you:

1. In or about the spring of 1986 you did obtain unauthorized assistance in an academic examination contrary to S.E.1.(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.
2. In or about the spring of 1986 you did represent as your own in academic work submitted for credit in a course or program of study ideas and expressions of ideas of other students, contrary to S.E.1.(a)(ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.
3. In or about the spring of 1986 you did obtain unauthorized assistance in an academic examination contrary to S.E.1.(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.
4. In or about the spring of 1986 you did represent as your own in academic work submitted for credit in a course or program of study ideas and expressions of ideas of other students, contrary to S.E.1.(a)(ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.
5. In or about the spring of 1986 you did obtain unauthorized assistance in an academic examination contrary to S.E.1.(a)(i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.
6. In or about the spring of 1986 you did represent as your own in academic work submitted for credit in a course or program of study ideas and expressions of ideas of other students, contrary to S.E.1.(a)(ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour.
