Dear Mr. **G.**

At its hearing on July 30th, 1987, the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That you did make use of a forged or falsified academic record of the University of Toronto in order to obtain the Bachelor of Education degree contrary to Section E.1(c) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. When you were admitted to the Faculty of Education, you used a forged or falsified diploma as proof that you had obtained the Bachelor of Arts degree in order to obtain the Bachelor of Education degree.

The jury found you guilty of the charge and made the following recommendations to the President of the University of Toronto:

That your Bachelor of Education degree be revoked;

That your Bachelor of Education degree be replaced by a Diploma in Technical Education.

The jury gave the following reason for this decision: "The requirements for a Bachelor of Education degree were not satisfied; however, the requirements for the diploma were satisfied."

Information concerning rights of appeal may be found in Section L of the Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The deadline for filing an appeal by you or by the University is August 25th, 1987.
