

REASONS

This is an appeal from the decision of the Trial Division of the University Tribunal rendered on June 26, 1987. The trial was in respect to three charges brought against the Appellant by the University of Toronto pursuant to the provisions of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters as approved by the Governing Council of the University of Toronto on June 20, 1985. The appellant pleaded guilty to all charges before the Trial Division and was sentenced.

The appeal came on for hearing before us on September 28, October 26 and November 3, 1987. On November 3, 1987 and after we had heard considerable argument on October 26, 1987, Mr. Salgo informed us that the Appellant had instructed him that she had no desire to proceed with the appeal or to seek a new trial. Accordingly, we ordered the appeal dismissed.
