Dear Mr. C.

At its hearing on Thursday, July 27th, 1989 the University Tribunal considered the following charge against you:

That on or about April 13th, 1989, you did possess an unauthorized aid, being a crib sheet, at an academic examination in ECO 311, contrary to Section E.1. (a) (i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.

The jury found you guilty of the charge and imposed the following sanctions:

- a grade of zero in the final examination in ECO 311;
- that the decision and sanction imposed be reported to the Vice-President and Provost for publication (name withheld) in the University newspapers.

The jury gave the following reasons for their decision: "We considered the general deterrent. We feel that the appropriate mark in the examination shall be zero. Since this is his first offence and we are confident that he will not repeat this offence, there shall be no record on his transcript. And since it is anonymous, we feel that the general public should be told of the offence and its consequence through publication by the Provost."

Information concerning rights of appeal may be found in Section L of the Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The deadline for filing an appeal by you or by the University is August 22nd, 1989.
