At its hearing on Tuesday, March 27th, 1990 the University Tribunal considered the following charges against you:

## Charge One

1. that in or about March 1989, you did submit for credit in the course POL302Y an essay entitled "Mrs. Thatcher's prescription for British economic revival will inevitably place the country's southern economy in a continental orbit, while the north continues its decay", which essay was purchased by you from Custom Essay Service and, therefore, represented as your work the work of Custom Essay Service, contrary to Section E.1. (a) (ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.
2. that in or about March 1989, you did use or possess in connection with a form of academic work an unauthorized aid, being an essay ordered from Custom Essay Service, contrary to Section E.1. (a) (i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The essay was used or possessed in connection with an essay entitled "Mrs. Thatcher's prescription for British economic revival will inevitably place the country's southern economy in a continental orbit, while the north continues its decay", submitted for credit in POL302Y in or about March 1989.

## Charge Two

1. that in or about March 1989, you did submit for credit in the course PHL340S an essay entitled "A Consideration of Consciousness", which essay was purchased by you from Custom Essay Service and, therefore, represented as your work the work of Custom Essay Service, contrary to Section E.1. (a) (ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.

2. that in or about March 1989, you did use or possess an unauthorized aid, being an essay ordered from Custom Essay Service, contrary to Section E.1. (a) (i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The essay was used or possessed in connection with an essay entitled "A Consideration of Consciousness", submitted for credit in PHL340S in or about March 1989.

Charge Three

1. that in or about March 1989, you did submit for credit in the course POL200Y an untitled essay which was purchased from Custom Essay Service, contrary to Section E.1. (a) (ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters.
2. that in or about March 1989, you did use or possess an unauthorized aid, being an essay ordered from Custom Essay Service, contrary to Section E.1. (a) (i) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The essay was used or possessed in connection with an untitled essay submitted for credit in POL200Y in or about March 1989.

The jury accepted your plea of guilty to the charges and imposed the following sanctions:

- a permanent grade of zero in each of the eight courses in which you were registered in the 1988-89 academic year;
- suspension from the University for a period of five years, from the 1990-91 academic year until the 1995-96 academic year;
- that the suspension and the reason for it be recorded on your academic transcript for a period of ten years; and
- that the decision and sanction imposed be reported to the Vice-President and Provost for publication (name withheld) in the University newspapers.

The jury gave the following reasons for their decision: "...that this is a second major offence,<sup>1</sup> in this case a multiple offence. This led us to consider expulsion, but we were persuaded from this course of action by the Dean's and counsels' pleas for leniency and by the hope that the accused will indeed rehabilitate herself. In this regard, we encourage her to continue with the counselling mentioned."
