Dear Mr B,

At its hearing on June 30, 1992, the University Tribunal considered the following charges against you:

1. that on or about May 31, 1991, you submitted for credit in ACC 804H parts of Assignment 1 in which you represented as your own an idea or expression of an idea or work of another contrary to Section E.1(a)(ii) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters, 1985.
- 2., that on about July 22, 1991, you submitted for credit in ACC804H all or parts of Assignment 3 in which you represented as your own an idea or work of another contrary to Section B.1.1(b) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters, 1991.
3. that on or about July 22, 1991, you submitted for credit in ACC 805H all of parts of Assignment 3 in which you represented as your own an idea or expression of an idea or work of another contrary to Section B.1.1(b) of the University of Toronto Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters, 1991.

The jury found you guilty of the charges and agreed upon the following sanctions:

- (a) a zero on the three assignments which are the subject of these proceedings, namely, Assignments 1 and 3 in ACC804H and Assignment 3 in ACC805H;
- (b) suspension from the University for a period of 12 months;
- (c) that this sanction be recorded on your transcript for a period of 3 years;
- (4) that the Tribunal report this case to the Provost who may publish a notice of the decision of the Tribunal and the sanction or

sanctions imposed in the University newspapers, with the name of the student withheld.

jointly submitted by your counsel and the University Counsel, and agreed that these were appropriate to the nature of the offences committed and the case in general.

Information concerning rights of appeal may be found in Section L of the Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters. The deadline for filing an appeal by you or by the University is July 31st, 1992.
