ITEM IDENTIFICATION:

University of Toronto Mississauga, Renovations to the 4th floor William G Davis building to create new biology teaching labs.

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

Pursuant to Section 5.2. (b) of its Terms of Reference, the Business Board approves Expenditures for, and the execution of, approved Capital Projects.

PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

Approved at Planning & Budget, Nov. 2nd and Academic Board Nov. 17th.

HIGHLIGHTS:

The project will renovate 1,700 GSM (18,300 GSF) to create new biology teaching labs. Renovations include asbestos abatement, new benching, fumehoods, ducting, lighting and finishes.

Benefits will include increased hands-on lab time for students, reduced group sizes, and an improved teaching environment.

FINANCIAL AND/OR PLANNING IMPLICATIONS:

The total project cost is \$8,600,000 with an average construction cost of \$3,060 per GSM or \$284 per GSF.

RISK IMPLICATIONS:

Project must be implemented in a short time frame from April-August incl. 2012.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Vice President Business Affairs be authorized to implement the UTM Biology teaching lab renovation project at a total cost of \$8,600,000 with sources of funding as follows:

Provincial Government \$5,400,000 UTM operating funds \$3,200,000
