David Naylor Installed as Fifteenth President of the University of Toronto

Professor David Naylor was installed as the 15th president of the University of Toronto at a ceremony Monday, Nov. 7, Convocation Hall, 31 King's College Circle.

Lieutenant-Governor James Bartleman and Mayor David Miller along with federal and provincial elected representatives were among those presenting greetings, along with representatives of other Ontario universities, faculty, staff, students and alumni. In his <u>installation</u> <u>address</u> Naylor outlined his vision for the university.

Formerly dean of the Faculty of Medicine and vice-provost (relations with health care institutions) at the University of Toronto, Naylor received his MD from U of T and DPhil from Oxford University where he was a Rhodes scholar in social and administrative studies. His five-year term as president officially began Oct. 1, 2005.

The ceremony was simulcast to audience locations at the University of Toronto at Mississauga (CCIT Building, Main Floor Lobby) and University of Toronto at Scarborough (Meeting Place, Science Wing), and was also available by webcast.
