

Voting Instructions for the 2012 Academic Board Election Librarian Staff

For the purposes of the Academic Board elections, Librarian staff means an employee of the University, University College, the Constituent Colleges, and the arts and science faculties of Federated Universities who hold the rank of Librarian I, Librarian II, Librarian III, or Librarian IV.

Please read the instructions and the candidates' statements provided below before voting.

Online Voting

1. All librarian staff who have an email account within the utoronto.ca domain registered in the Human Resources Information System (HRIS) must vote on-line at the website listed below.

2. Voting commences at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, February 27, 2012, and concludes on Friday, March 9, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.
3. You may vote for only one (1) candidate out of the two (2) candidates.
4. To access the on-line ballot, you must enter your personnel number and date of birth¹.
5. Verification of your eligibility to vote in the administrative staff election will be determined by records provided by the HRIS and the Human Resource Offices of the federated universities.
6. Once the system has recognized you as a valid voter, you will be directed to the librarian staff ballot.
7. Once you have accessed the ballot, you **MUST** cast your vote. If you log-on and then exit the ballot without voting, you will not be able to re-access the ballot.
8. If you do not select a candidate, a warning message will inform you that a selection has not been made. If you choose to cast a blank vote, the ballot will be accepted as submitted.

After your vote is registered, you cannot access the ballot a second time
