Governing Council Elections

Ballots will be mailed out the week of week of February 17, 2009 to those administrative staff who do not have University of Toronto email addresses. All online votes must be cast, and mail ballots returned by March 20, 2009 at 5:00 p.m.

- ii. Librarian staff elections will be held online between Monday, March 9 and Friday, March 20, 2009. All online votes must be cast, and mail ballots returned by March 20, 2009 at 5:00 p.m.
