

Admissions - Definition of Ontario Resident

At the May 17, 1979 meeting of the Governing Council the following motion was approved:

That for purposes of admissions to the University of Toronto, an Ontario Resident be defined as follows:

The applicant must be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant who has resided in the Province of Ontario for a period of twelve consecutive months immediately prior to September 1 in the year in which the programme begins, or* to the last date (to be specified) of application. A Canadian citizen or landed immigrant who wishes to submit a request for consideration for exemption from this definition should present the reasons for the request in writing to the Faculty.

*The choice would be at the discretion of the division involved, which would then state one or the other in its literature.
