### Section III: Definitions

For election to the UTSC Campus Council, the candidate and nominators must have a primary appointment at the University of Toronto Scarborough. Normally, one of the two administrative staff positions will be reserved for a librarian.

The definition of “**Administrative Staff**” below is an extract from the *Election Guidelines 2017*. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are eligible by consulting the *Election Guidelines 2017*, which provides more details for this definition and the eligibility criteria.

“Administrative Staff” means the staff-appointed employees of the University, University College, the Constituent Colleges and the Federated Universities who are not members of the Teaching Staff thereof”.

### Section IV: Candidate Statement

The nominee may submit a typed biographical statement or other comments, up to a limit of 100 words. The candidate's name will not be counted in the 100-word total if placed at the beginning of the statement. Abbreviations and acronyms will be counted as one word. The nominee’s URL will not be counted in the 100 word limit and should be placed at the end of the statement. **This statement may be published in the campus media and will be linked to the ballot on the web. If a statement exceeds 100 words, only the first 100 words will be printed.**
