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## **Section II: Requirements**

## Nominee's Responsibility

It is the Nominee's responsibility to file a bona fide nomination. Errors or irregularities in these papers constitute grounds for rejection of the nomination. Errors or irregularities may be corrected prior to the close of nominations. Please refer to the <u>Election Guidelines 2018</u> for additional instructions. The Office of the Governing Council will attempt to notify candidates of the existence of any errors or irregularities during this period, but it is not bound to do so. Candidates are advised to complete and submit their nomination papers early in the nomination period.

## **Section III: Definitions**

The definition of "Graduate Student" and "Student" below is an extract from the *Election Guidelines* 2018. It is your responsibility to ensure that you are eligible by consulting the *Election Guidelines* 2018, which provides more details for this definition and the eligibility criteria.

"Graduate Student" means a Student registered in the School of Graduate Studies.

"Student" means any person registered at the University for full-time or part-time study in a program that leads to a degree or post-secondary diploma or certificate of the University or in a program designated by the Governing Council as a program of post-secondary study at the University. The Transitional Year Program and the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program have been designated by the Governing Council as programs of post-secondary study at the University, and, accordingly, a student in either of these programs is considered a "Student" in these *Guidelines*.
