Provost's Annual Report on Cases of Academic Discipline

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

The *Code of Behaviour on Academic Matters, 1995* requires the Provost to report annually in statistical format on cases of academic discipline to Academic Board.

PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

N.A.

HIGHLIGHTS:

The number of divisional discipline cases has dropped by 10% since last year's report, with the sharpest decline occurring at UTM (about 35%). The decline is seen in both of the two largest types of offenses, plagiarism and collaboration. The University Tribunal considered two cases last year, compared to eight in the previous year.
