PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

HIGHLIGHTS:

The Divisional Academic Plan of the University of Toronto Mississauga is the product of a broadly inclusive consultative process. As described in the Plan, the Vice-Principal Academic and Dean formed an Academic Planning Committee in 2011 to guide the planning process. Consultation with the community began during the fall of 2011 with the discussion of a draft set of values. The Divisional Plan builds on a unit self-study and planning process, emphasizing themes and issues that emerged from the planning process and from final unit plans. Public consultation around the draft plan occurred during the fall, 2012. The plan was approved by the Provost in late September 2012. The final UTM Academic Plan was endorsed by the Erindale College Council (ECC) at its meeting on November 12, 2012.

The five year Academic Plan for the University of Toronto Mississauga presents a wide range of commitments and goals connected to the Division's twelve core values, focusing in particular on expansion while improving the Division's faculty: student ratio; expanding and renovating campus facilities; building on already strong connections with the local community; increasing support for research; and encouraging pedagogical innovation and experiential learning including increased student engagement in research.
