Approvals Under Summer Executive Authority

The Governing Council, at its meeting of June 27, 2002, approved the annual delegation of authority to permit the President to act on behalf of the Council during the summer months. Council delegated authority for "decisions on . . . matters the urgency of which does not permit their deferral until the next regular meeting of the Governing Council or its appropriate standing committee or board." The delegation specified "that all actions taken under this authority be approved prior to implementation by the Chairman of the Governing Council and reported to the appropriate committee or board for information."

For the summer of 2002, there were no matters within the purview of the Business Board approved under summer executive authority.
