The Governing Council, at its meeting of Monday, November 1, 2004, will be asked to accept and reaffirm the principles and directions outlined in the University of Toronto submission, dated October 28, 2004, to the Honourable Bob Rae, Advisor to the Premier and the Minister of Training, Colleges and Universities on Postsecondary Education.

Professor Carolyn Tuohy, Vice-President, Government and Institutional Relations, has kindly agreed; (a) to provide a short oral briefing to the Business Board on aspects of the University's submission that will be of most interest to the Board, and (b) to advise members on how they can be most effective in assisting the University in advocating its views.
