  - We have multiple mechanisms to support the development of teaching excellence






### 1. President's Teaching Award & The Teaching Academy



- Highest teaching honour at U of T, recognizing sustained excellence in teaching, research in teaching, and the integration of teaching and research
- Each recipient also designated by the University as a member of *The Teaching Academy* – an advisory group to the President and Provost, and to the Director of CTSI
- As teaching advocates they participate and lead various initiatives and profile the University's commitment to high-quality teaching and learning

# THE TEACHING ACADEMY: Examples of Initiatives



Open Doors: Observation of classes taught by Teaching Academy members, followed by discussion.



Teaching Matters: Ongoing series of articles/videos highlighting teaching innovation at U of Exploring Large Classroom Teaching A variety Dell'ridee, print resources and websites to help fast your thinking and support your twedning of large classes.

Large Class Teaching: Sub-committee development of workshops and an online module (videos and print resources).

### 2. A New Course Evaluation Framework

- 1. Broad consultation by a provostial working group evidence based institution-wide reform of policy and practice
- 1. Adoption of a SINGLE, CENTRALLY SUPPORTED, CUSTOMIZABLE ONLINE system.
- New framework provides data at the institutional, divisional, departmental, and instructor levels – for formative and summative purposes.


