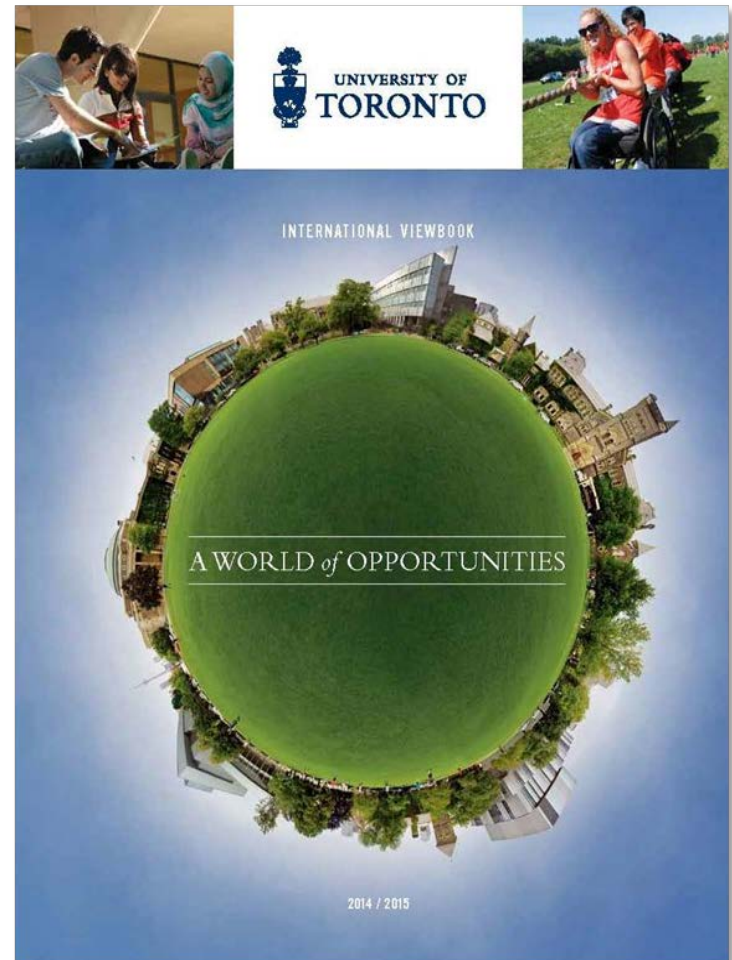
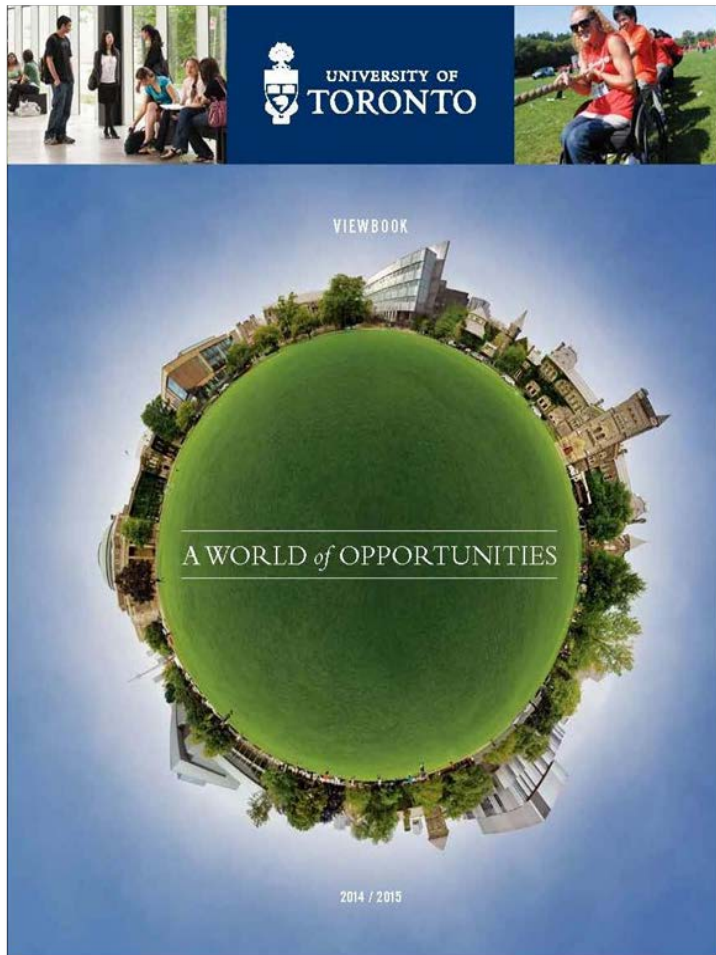

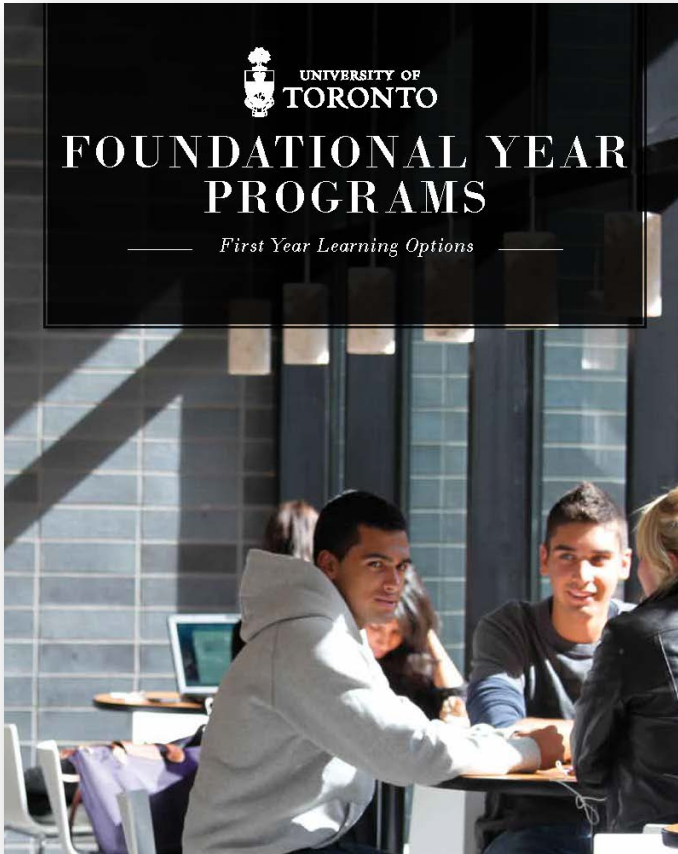

Early Admission Offers

Quicker turn around on applications

- **2012**

February admission offers doubled (4,000)

- **2013**

February admission offers further increased (6,000)

- **2014**

Earlier admission decisions sent to applicants outside of Ontario



President's Scholars of Excellence Program

- President's Entrance Scholarships introduced in 2010
- Surveyed applicants who declined offers of admission
- New PSEP was created out of feedback from survey
- Pilot implementation of PSEP in 2013-2014
- Common program components among divisions:
 - * \$5,000 first-year scholarship
 - * Guaranteed PT job in second year
 - * Guaranteed access to international opportunity
 - * Guaranteed faculty mentor (*some divisions*)
 - * Guaranteed research opportunity (*some divisions*)
