### UTM CAMPUS AFFAIRS COMMITTEE LEVEL 1 CAPITAL PROJECTS ANNUAL REPORT (2015) FOR INFORMATION

**Level 1 Capital Projects**, those less than \$3 million, are subject to local review and approval by UTM's Space Planning & Management Committee (SPMC), chaired by the Chief Administrative Officer. SPMC submits annual reports to the UTM Campus Affairs Committee for information.

Generally, the purpose of SPMC is to review and approve proposals (valued at less than \$3 million) for the use of space at UTM, including those which involve new construction, renovations, or changes in occupancy or use. Proposals related to outdoor space are considered by SPMC only after they have been reviewed by the Grounds Monitoring Committee.

Campus infrastructure and/or work related to deferred maintenance that are not part of a renovation project are carried out under the auspices of the department of CAO and the Department of Facilities Management & Planning (FMP): they are outside the Level 1 Capital Projects process but are reported annually to SPMC, for information. To provide a comprehensive overview, those projects for 2015 have been included in this report.
