HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) Visits and Orders

During this reporting period (October 1 – December 31, 2015) the Ministry of Labour visited the University St. George Campus six times, no order issued.

One critical injury was reported to the Ministry of Labour during this period. A visitor tripped and fell resulting with a fractured elbow. No hazardous conditions WERE found at this location.
