PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

No previous action in governance has been taken on this item.

HIGHLIGHTS:

The 2016-17 Sessional Dates were established to bear a resemblance to the 2015-16 dates. There were no challenges or issues establishing Summer 2016 dates. However, classes begin two days prior to the Labour Day holiday for the Fall 2016 session in order to conclude the semester by December 21st. In addition, the loss of the gym due to the Highland Hall renovation project resulted in the exam period being extended by one day. In Winter 2017, classes begin on January 2nd and the final exam period concludes on April 22nd providing more time for convocation preparation during the month of June.

Summer 2016: Starts Monday, May 2nd with last day of classes being Tuesday, August 2nd (makeup day for Friday). Reading week (June 14-18), 3 days of study break (August 3-5), 13 days of exams (August 6-20).

Fall 2016: Starts Thursday, September 1st with last day of classes being Thursday, December 1st (makeup day for Monday). Reading week (October 11-15), 2 days of study break (December 2-3), 14 days of exams (December 5-20).

Winter 2017: Starts Monday, January 2nd with last day of classes being Friday, March 31st (no makeup days required). Reading week (February 21-25), 3 days of study break (April 1-4), 14 days of exams (April 5-22).
