ITEM IDENTIFICATION:

The Ramsay Wright Building Teaching Laboratories Upgrades - Execution of the Project.

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

Section 5.2 (b) of the terms of reference for the Business Board states that the Board is responsible for "approval of capital expenditures for, and the execution of, approved projects, as required by approved policies."

PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

In June 2013, Governing Council approved in principle the Project Planning Report for the Ramsay Wright Building Teaching Laboratories Upgrade and in addition, approved in principle the project scope totalling 7,800 gross square metres (approximately 3,846 net assignable square metres), to be funded by the Faculty of Arts and Science, Graduate Expansion Funds and borrowing as follows:

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

a) Total Project Cost Estimate

The original proposed Total Project Cost (TPC) for all phases of the Ramsay Wright Building Teaching Laboratories Upgrades project was \$14,680,000 and consisted of 3 phases \$8,550,000, \$3,672,000 and \$2,458,000.

The revised TPC is **\$24,300,000**, an increase of \$9,620,000.

The increases in cost can be grouped as follows:
