**ITEM IDENTIFICATION:**

Student Societies: Requests for Fee Increases – University of Toronto St. George and Multi-Campus

**JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:**

Section 5 of the University Affairs Board Terms of Reference list student societies and compulsory non-academic incidental fees among the Board's areas of responsibility.

Sections 5.2.1 and 5.2.2 provide that compulsory non-academic incidental fees for representative student committees and divisional student societies "are approved by the Board."

Student society fees are subject to the terms and conditions of the *Policy on Ancillary Fees* (Category 2.0, "Student organizations and services provided by such organizations," and Category 3.0, "Student levies for specific, limited projects"), and the *Policy for Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees* (Preamble, Section A., and in particular, Section B.).

Section B.4. of the *Policy for Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees* outlines the general expectations with respect to increases of student society fees:

*Requests to change the fee collected on behalf of a student society and requests for new fees shall be approved only when evidence has been presented that the request has been authorized by due constitutional process in the organization. The procedures to request approval of a new fee or an increase to an existing fee shall be published in the Handbook for Student Societies.*

*Cost of Living Increases*

- (a) *Where the amount of an increase in the fee charged is not greater than the year-over-year change in consumer prices for Ontario as measured by Statistics Canada (December-over-December) as of December 31 of the previous year, the request must be supported by the results of a previous referendum approving the principle of a cost-of-living adjustment. In special circumstances (e.g., when a portion of a student society fee is designated for a health plan or capital project), other inflation indexes or predetermined inflation factors may be used, provided that the request is supported by the results of a previous referendum approving the use of the specific inflation index or predetermined inflation factor.*

#### *Referendum Requirement*

- (b) *Where the amount of an increase in the fee charged is greater than the year-over-year change in consumer prices, the request must be supported by the majority of the society's members voting in a recent referendum.*

In summary, increases that are greater than the cost of living must be supported by a referendum. Other increases must be supported by a previous referendum approving the concept of annual increases by the cost of living or an explicit inflation factor. When such a provision is approved by a referendum, annual increases, no greater than the Ontario Consumer Price Index of the previous December, or no greater than a specific inflation factor approved by referendum, may be requested upon approval of the board or council of the organization.

The administrative procedures are outlined in the *Policy on Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees* and the *Handbook for Student Societies* (published by the Office of the Vice-Provost, Students). Pursuant to the *Policy*, requests for increases to fees must be supported by due constitutional and fair processes within student societies.

Requests for increases are brought forward to the Board by the administration on the assurances of the student societies that due constitutional procedures have been followed. If a complaint is received about the process related to a fee request from a student society, the Office of the Vice-Provost, Students makes inquiries about the issue and, if necessary, investigates the matter further as part of the assessment of the request.

## RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the University Affairs Board approve the following:

### BE IT RESOLVED

THAT beginning in the fall 2016 session, the **Association of Part-time Undergraduate Students** fee be increased as follows: (a) an increase of \$0.05 per session in the Canadian Federation of Students (CFS)/CFS-Ontario portion of the fee; (b) an increase of \$4.93 per fall and winter session in the Accident & Prescription Drug Insurance Plan portion of the fee; and (c) an increase of \$4.11 per fall and winter session in the Dental Plan portion of the fee.

THAT beginning in the fall 2016 session, the **Engineering Society** fee be changed as follows: (a) an increase of \$0.41 per fall and winter session in the society portion of the fee (\$0.39 part-time); and (b) the continuation and decrease of \$0.05 in the Skule Nite portion of the fee (full-time only).

THAT beginning in the fall 2016 session, the **Faculty of Music Undergraduate Association** society fee be increased as follows: (a) an increase of \$42.50 per fall and winter session in the society portion of the fee (full-time only); (b) the establishment of a designated FMUA Clubs, Events and Services Fee of \$100.00 per fall and winter session (full-time only); (c) the establishment of a designated FMUA endowment portion of the fee of \$100.00 per fall and winter session (full-time only); and (d) the establishment of a designated FMUA special projects fund portion of the fee of \$200.00 per fall and winter session (full-time only).

THAT beginning in the fall 2016 session, the **University College Literary and Athletic Society** (UC Lit) fee be increased as follows: (a) the establishment of a designated University College Literary and Athletic Society special project levy portion of the fee of \$12.50 per fall and winter session (\$5.00 part-time).

THAT beginning in the fall 2016 session, the **University of Toronto Graduate Students' Union** fee be increased as follows: (a) an increase of \$10.98 per fall and winter session in the Supplementary Health Coverage portion of the fee (full-time only); (b) an increase of \$9.68 (full-time) per fall and winter session in the Dental Plan portion of the fee (\$9.68 part-time); (c) the establishment of a new part-time Supplementary Health Coverage designated portion of the fee of \$137.01 per fall and winter session (part-time only); (d) an increase of \$0.09 per session in the Canadian Federation of Students (CFS)/CFS-Ontario portion of the fee (\$0.05 part-time); (e) an increase of \$0.01 per session in the Bikechain portion of the fee (\$0.01 part-time for the fall session only); (f) an increase of \$0.05 per fall session and \$0.04 per winter session in the OPIRG portion of the fee (\$0.02 per fall and winter sessions part-time); and (g) an increase of \$0.01 per session in the Sexual Education Centre portion of the fee (\$0.01 part-time for the winter session only).

THAT beginning in the fall 2016 session, the **University of Toronto Students' Union** (UTSU, legally the Students' Administrative Council) fees be increased as follows: (a) an increase of \$0.31 per session in the society portion of the fee; (b) an increase of \$0.01 per session in the Student Refugee Program portion of the fee; (c) an increase of \$0.01 per session in the Bikechain portion of the fee; (d) an increase of \$0.13 per session in the Canadian Federation of Students (CFS)/CFS-Ontario portion of the fee; (e) an increase of \$4.66 per fall and winter session in the Accident & Prescription Drug Plan portion of the fee; (f) an increase of \$3.25 per fall and winter session in the Dental Plan portion of the fee; (g) for full-time undergraduates on the St. George Campus only, an increase of \$0.29 per session in the Student Commons portion of the fee; (h) for full-time undergraduates on the St. George Campus only, an increase of \$0.05 per session in the Downtown Legal Services portion of the fee; (i) for full-time undergraduates on the UTM Campus only, an increase of \$0.02 per session in the Downtown Legal Services portion of the fee, and (j) for full-time undergraduates on the St. George Campus only the establishment of a designated LGBTQOUT portion of the fee of \$0.25 per fall and winter session.

THAT beginning in the fall 2016 session, the **Varsity Publications Inc.** society fee be increased as follows: (a) an increase of \$0.03 per session in the society portion of the fee.

**Re:** Student Society Proposals for Fee Increases

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The Office of the Vice-Provost, Students has received a number of fee change requests from student societies. The applications have been reviewed in light of the requirements of the *Policy for Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees*, are found to be in compliance with these requirements, and are recommended for approval.

Requests for fee increases from student societies must meet a number of requirements. Section B.4 of the *Policy for Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees* outlines the University's general expectations:

*Requests to change the fee collected on behalf of a student society and requests for new fees shall be approved only when evidence has been presented that the request has been authorized by due constitutional process in the organization. The procedures to request approval of a new fee or an increase to an existing fee shall be published in the Handbook for Student Societies.*

*Cost of Living Increases*

- (a) *Where the amount of an increase in the fee charged is not greater than the year-over-year change in consumer prices for Ontario as measured by Statistics Canada (December-over-December) as of December 31 of the previous year, the request must be supported by the results of a previous referendum approving the principle of a cost-of-living adjustment. In special circumstances (e.g., when a portion of a student society fee is designated for a health plan or capital project), other inflation indexes or predetermined inflation factors may be used, provided that the request is supported by the results of a previous referendum approving the use of the specific inflation index or predetermined inflation factor.*

### *Referendum Requirement*

- (b) *Where the amount of an increase in the fee charged is greater than the year-over-year change in consumer prices, the request must be supported by the majority of the society's members voting in a recent referendum.*

The procedures for handling fee change requests (from the *Handbook for Student Societies* published by the Office of the Vice-Provost, Students) also provide that requests for a fee increase must be supplied with the following:

*Evidence that the request to change the existing fee (or to institute a new charge) has been authorized by due constitutional process of the organization. This evidence should include a copy of or specific reference to the section of the society's constitution which relates to the mechanism for fee changes, minutes of the meeting at which the resolution to request the change was passed, details and results of any referenda related to the subject which may have been held within the division, and publicity given the matter to ensure that those who may be affected by the change are aware of the proposal, including size and purpose of the increase, and have had the opportunity to make their views known.*

Normally, the administration intersects with these processes at two points. Initially, it is recommended that student societies seek advice from the Office of the Vice-Provost, Students on the wording of referendum questions (with respect to clarity and technical language). The second point occurs after the referendum when the student society makes the formal request for a fee increase. The recommendation for approval is derived from the assessment of whether the society has met the requirements articulated in the *Policy* and the relevant procedures.

Occasionally, the Office is asked to look into complaints about referendum procedures and compliance with relevant portions of the society's constitution and/or by-laws. The results of these investigations play a significant role in the assessment of the request and the recommendation for approval.

The assessment of requests for fee increases is normally based upon the following expectations:

- 1) The student society must make the request in a manner consistent with the *Policy for Compulsory Non-Academic Incidental Fees* and the University's procedures for increases to student society fees;
- 2) When required, there must be a positive result in a referendum for a fee increase (special conditions established by the society's by-laws, such as quorum, must also be met);
- 3) The referendum question itself should be clear and provide enough information to students in order to gain a full understanding of the implications of the question and proposed fee for them;

- 4) The referendum must be held in a fair manner, advertised and promoted in a reasonable manner, and the members of each organization should be given a reasonable opportunity to vote; and
- 5) Each organization must comply with the provisions of its own by-laws, rules of procedure, and specific policies and procedures approved by the society's board or council.

Societies which have previously received approval (by referendum) from their members for an annual cost of living increase in the society's portion of the fee may request increases, upon approval by the society's board or council, of up to the previous Ontario December to December cost of living increase (consumer price index) calculated by Statistics Canada. The December 2015 consumer price index for Ontario was 1.7%.

As outlined in the excerpt from the *Policy* above, where members of a society have given consent (through a previous referendum) to the concept of inflationary increases according to a specific inflation factor or measure, this factor or measure may be used in place of CPI. For example, the University of Toronto Students' Union (the UTSU, or legally the Students' Administrative Council), the Graduate Students' Union (the GSU), and the Association of Part-Time Undergraduate Students (APUS) may request increases in the designated portions of their fees for health and dental plans at a rate established by approval of a previous referendum. UTSU and APUS may request increases in their health and dental plan fees of up to 10%. The GSU may request increases in its health and dental plan fees of an amount less than or equal to a health industry index.

It is important to note that when dealing with a student society request for a fee change, it is the society's own constitution, by-laws or established policies that set the standards for acceptable results in referenda. In some cases, society constitutions establish a minimum voter turnout in order to consider a referendum result to be valid. The University has not established additional criteria with respect to valid referendum voter turnout.

In addition, with respect to both requests for increases based upon the results of a referendum, and increases which require only the approval of the society's board or council, the administration relies on the assurances of student societies that due constitutional processes and fair procedures have been followed.

The session in which a student society's fee is applied is at the society's discretion. While not all societies charge summer fees, others have chosen to have their fees apply for all academic terms. Additionally, some societies have elected to have only certain portions of their fee charged in the summer term. For example, student societies that provide health and dental insurance plans only collect those portions of the fee in the fall and winter terms. For specific details of which fees are assessed in each term, please refer to the summary of changes document.

## ***Association of Part-time Undergraduate Students (APUS)***

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### **Background**

In fall/winter of 2015-16, the APUS fee was \$108.44 per session charged to all part-time undergraduate students on all campuses. The fee included \$3.84 per session for the Canadian Federation of Students (CFS)/CFS-Ontario; \$49.31 (including an administration fee and sales tax) per session for Accident & Prescription Drug Insurance Plan; and \$41.14 (including an administration fee and sales tax) per session for a Dental Plan.

### **Requests**

- 1) A cost of living increase in the Canadian Federation of Students (CFS) & CFS-Ontario portion of the fee.

At its meeting held on April 1, 2016, the APUS Board of Directors approved a resolution to request a cost of living increase to the Canadian Federation of Students (CFS) & CFO-Ontario portion of the fee.

In the course of considering this request, the Office of the Vice-Provost, Students has not received any complaints.

- 2) An inflationary increase in the Accident & Prescription Drug Insurance portion of the fee.

At its meeting held on April 1, 2016, the APUS Board of Directors approved a resolution to request an inflationary increase to the Accident & Prescription Drug Insurance Plan portion of the fee.

In the course of considering this request, the Office of the Vice-Provost, Students has not received any complaints.

- 3) An inflationary increase in the Dental Plan portion of the fee.

At its meeting held on April 1, 2016, the APUS Board of Directors approved a resolution to request an inflationary increase to the Dental Plan portion of the fee.

In the course of considering this request, the Office of the Vice-Provost, Students has not received any complaints.

## ***University of Toronto Engineering Society***

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### **Background**

In the fall/winter 2015-16, the University of Toronto Engineering Society fee was \$152.03 per session, charged to all full-time Faculty of Applied Science & Engineering students (\$22.96 per session for part-time students and Professional Experience Year [PEY] students). The fee included \$24.43 per session (\$22.96 part-time) for the society portion of the fee; and \$1.95 for the Skule Night portion of the fee.

### **Requests**

- 1) A cost of living increase in the society portion of the fee.

At its meeting held on February 27, 2016, the University of Toronto Engineering Society Council approved a resolution to seek a cost of living increase in the society portion of the fee.

In the course of considering this request, the Office of the Vice-Provost, Students has not received any complaints.

- 2) The continuation and decrease of the Skule Night portion of the fee through the 2017-18 fall/winter academic period.

A referendum was held from March 2, 2016 to March 4, 2016, in which Applied Science and Engineering students were asked to support the continuation of the levy for the next two years. The wording of the question is as follows:

#### *Preamble*

*The Engineering Society is seeking consent from its members to continue the levy for Skule Nite. The levy will be \$1.90 per session per student (\$3.80 per Fall & Winter academic sessions.) If the levy is approved, it will continue to be charged*

*to all full-time undergraduate Applied Science and Engineering students in fall 2016 and fall 2017. Subsequent referendum approval will be required to continue the fee after the 2017/2018 session. Are you in favour of continuing the Skule Nite Levy as outlined above?*

If approved, the total Engineering Society fee will be \$152.39 (\$23.35 part-time) per fall and winter session, charged to all Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering students.

### **Faculty of Music Undergraduate Association (FMUA)**

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#### **Background**

In the fall/winter 2015-16, the Faculty of Music Undergraduate Association fee was \$607.50 per session, charged to all full-time undergraduate Faculty of Music students. The fee included \$7.50 per session (full-time only) for the society portion of the fee and \$600.00 for a Special Levy designated portion of the fee.

#### **Requests**

- 1) An increase to the society portion of the fee.

A referendum was held from November 23, 2015 to November 27, 2015, in which full-time undergraduate students in the Faculty of Music were asked to support the increase of the society portion of the FMUA fee. The wording of the question is as follows:

***FMUA Student Society Fee (Part A)***

*The Faculty of Music Undergraduate Association (FMUA) Society portion of the fee was \$15.00 in the 2015-16 academic year (\$7.50 per fall and winter term). The FMUA is proposing an annual increase of \$85.00 per year to the FMUA Student Society Fee, for a total annual fee of \$100.00 (\$50.00 per Fall & Winter academic terms) for all Faculty of Music undergraduate students. The FMUA Student Society Fee is the core funding for the organization and its operation. The increase will cover the cost of the Executive Director who will help in the operation of the organization and in providing services to students. The position is key to the success of the FMUA Endowment Fund and Special Projects Fund as well as securing the successful transition between Executives from year to year and the operation of FMUA services and business venture, specifically: Orientation, the FMUA Store and FMUA Café.*

If approved, the FMUA will be authorized to request annual cost-of-living increases, based on the December over December Ontario CPI to the designated Society Portion of the Fee, through a majority approval of the FMUA Board of Directors at a regular scheduled meeting.*

All undergraduate students registered with the Faculty of Music would contribute \$200.00 annually to the fund (\$100.00 per Fall & Winter academic terms) beginning in the fall of 2016 after which a review and referendum vote is required for its continuation. The fee will be used for FMUA clubs, events and co-curricular services such as: FMUA Orientation, Socials, FMUA Course Unions, the FMUA Store, FMUA Café, Mental Health and Wellness services, FMUA Study Hall and the FMUA Writing Centre.*

- 3) The establishment of a new FMUA Endowment Fund designated portion of the fee.

A referendum was held from November 23, 2015 to November 27, 2015, in which full-time undergraduate students in the Faculty of Music were asked to support the establishment of a new designated portion of the FMUA fee. The wording of the question is as follows:

***FMUA Endowment Fund***

*The Faculty of Music Undergraduate Association (FMUA) is seeking consent from its membership to establish the FMUA Endowment Fund. All undergraduate students registered with the Faculty of Music would contribute \$200.00 annually to the fund (\$100.00 per Fall & Winter academic terms) beginning in the fall of 2016 for the duration of 4 years, after which a review and*

*referendum vote is required for its continuation. Interest earned from the principal collected through the levy may be used each year to improve the co-curricular experience of Faculty of Music undergraduate students. In addition, the principal of the fund can be spent on capital projects such as the construction of student space in the future. The new project levy will contribute solely to the assistance of the cost of renovating student co-curricular spaces, including the Junior Common Room, the lounge in UC 376 (including a café), and the quadrangle. In appreciation of the students' contribution to the project, the College will begin the renovations of the Junior Common Room as early as possible. Moreover, the Society will obtain preferential booking for all students spaces and the right of first refusal for the operation of a student-run café in the lounge in UC 376. If the increase is approved, the total fee for the University College Literary & Athletic Society will increase from \$17.53 to \$30.03 per session for all Full-Time University College students and from \$8.15 to \$13.15 per session for all Part-time University College students, beginning September 2016. *Preamble:*

*The main goals of LGBTOUT are to foster safe and accessible spaces on campus for LGBTQ+ identified students, as well as to advocate and spread awareness around LGBTQ+ issues to the general community.*

*In acquiring a levy, LGBTOUT would be able to carry out much-needed advocacy work that has fallen by the wayside in past years. Events that facilitate*

*spaces for critical discussion and the spreading of awareness are greatly hindered by the need to produce revenue. As well, no matter how much consultation and collaboration is done for each event, there are still many barriers to accommodating the diverse array of accessibility needs in our community. For example, trans people of colour experience higher rates of poverty than the general community. These people need safe social spaces and, although events are available, they may be inaccessible based on commute and ticket costs, so a levy would make it possible for us to provide necessary subsidies and accommodations for those in need.*

*In addition, a levy would enable us to carry out orientation and beginning-of-the-year events with less concern. Current funding structures do not adequately support groups that take on long-term projects or provide large-scale projects and events during those critical first weeks of school.*

*LGBTOUT has requested that the University of Toronto Students' Union (UTSU) establish a refundable designated portion of the UTSU fee.*

*Pending the support of the UTSU's general membership at the St. George campus, the designated fee would be refundable to members, and subject to a formal Memorandum of Agreement concerning the payment of fees, member refunds, accountability for student fee revenue, and the terms and conditions related to the fee.*

*The UTSU is seeking consent from its members at the St. George campus to establish a new designated portion of the UTSU fee for the fall and winter sessions. The proposed increase is \$0.25 per session, paid by UTSU members at the St. George campus, beginning in the fall 2016 session.*

*1. Are you in favour of establishing a new refundable designated portion of the UTSU fee for LGBTOUT (Lesbians, Gays, Bisexuals and Trans People of the University of Toronto), as described in the preamble and subject to the terms and conditions above?*
