PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

The Business Board received a quarterly report for the period July 1 – September 30, 2016 at its meeting held on September 22, 2016.

HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) Visits and Orders

During this reporting period (October 1 – December 31, 2016) the Ministry of Labour visited the St. George Campus three times, no orders were issued.

One critical injury was reported during this period.

2. Regulatory Visits

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) Waste Division visited the University radioactive waste facility. No issues were reported.

3. Incidents Abroad Relating to Students

The Safety Abroad Office has not been advised of any injuries related to students abroad from October 1 to December 19, 2016.
