Minor Modification: Master of Management & Professional Accounting (MMPA) Course Change

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

Under section 5.6 of its terms of reference, the Academic Affairs Committee is responsible for major and minor modifications to existing programs.

PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

No previous action has been taken.

HIGHLIGHTS:

The University of Toronto Mississauga (UTM) currently houses five Professional Graduate Masters Programs under the Institute for Management and Innovation (IMI), including the Master of Management and Professional Accounting (MMPA) Program. The MMPA Program is seeking approval to change an existing course offering, MGT2282H (*Integration & Professional Decision Making Initiatives*), from a regular course (offered in its entirety within one academic session) to an extended course (course work continues across more than one academic session).

Within the MMPA Program, MGT2282H is a required course for second year students. Currently, this course is taught in two "halves" by separate instructors in two different terms. The first part of the course, Integration & Professional Decision Making Initiatives I is offered in

the Summer term of the second year of the Program and Integration & Professional Decision Making Initiatives II concludes the course in the subsequent Fall term. As the course is already offered over two academic terms, formalizing this by categorizing the course as extended will allow for correct reporting of final grades, easier scheduling, and smoother course administration between the two "halves".

MMPA students will not be effected by this change as the course will continue to be offered as it always has been. There are also no resource implications for the change.

This proposed course change was reviewed and approved by the IMI Curriculum Committee on March 27, 2017.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

There are no net implications for the campus' operating budget.

RECOMMENDATION:

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Part 2: Other Changes to Existing Courses

This is a proposal to modify the existing MGT2282H (Integration & Professional Decision Making Initiatives) course from a regular course offering to an extended course offering.

MGT2282H is a required course for MMPA students in their second year. Currently, this course is taught in two halves by separate instructors in two different terms (summer and fall).
