#### **PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:**

The annual report was provided for information to the Academic Affairs Committee on April 26, 2016.

#### HIGHLIGHTS:

The purpose of the information package is to inform the Academic Affairs Committee of the work of Committee on Standing (COS) specifically providing details concerning the focus of the work, the numbers of cases considered and the outcomes. It is not intended to create a discussion regarding individual cases or their specifics, as they were dealt with by a body, which was bound by due process and fairness. The COS reviews appeals for petitions decisions made by the Office of the Registrar.

The report covers the period between July 1, 2015 and June 30, 2016.

The report highlights the types of petitions assessed by the Office of the Registrar, totalling 5166 petitions in the given period. The COS met six times during this period and reviewed 37 appeals for a total of 24 students. Six appeals were granted, 29 refused and 2 cancelled. Eleven cases were appealed to the Academic Appeals Subcommittee.





Petitions Enrolment


### University of Toronto Mississauga Deferred Exams vs. Enrolment 2011-12 to 2015-16
