No previous action in governance has been taken on this item.

HIGHLIGHTS:

The 2018-19 Sessional Dates have been approved by the Dean's Office following extensive consultation. The Summer 2018 term will begin on Monday May 7, include a four-day reading week Tuesday June 12 through Friday June 22 and an eleven-day final examination period from Saturday August 11 through Friday August 24. On the final day of classes, Tuesday August 7, classes that normally meet on Mondays will be held in order to make-up for the loss of a Monday on Canada Day, Monday, July 2.

For Fall 2018, as was the case in 2017, classes will begin the day after Labour Day; the term will include a full reading week Monday October 8 (Thanksgiving) through Friday October 12 and a fourteen-day final examination period from Friday December 7 through Saturday October 22. There will be no make-up days required and unlike the Fall 2018 session, no Sunday exams will be required.

In Winter 2019, classes begin on Monday January 7, include a full reading week Monday February 18 (Family Day) through Friday February 22 and a fourteen-day final examination period from Wednesday April 10 through Saturday April 27, excluding Good Friday, April 19. No Sunday exams will be required.
