HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Ontario Ministry of Labour (MOL) Visits and Orders

During this reporting period (1 October – 31 December) the Ministry of Labour visited the St. George Campus 5 times, UTSC 3 times, UTM once. Three requirements/orders issued to the university. One order is regarding the requirement to provide information related to a construction project on the St George campus, and two regarding the provision of a procedure and training regarding caretakers who change lightbulbs on the St George campus.

Sao Paulo	October	Grad	Research	Student was taken to hospital due to flare up of pre-existing condition upon landing at the Sao Paulo airport.	Physical Health
Dehli	October	Undergrad	Internship	Student was mugged. Her passport and laptop were stolen.	Theft
Sri Lanka	November	Undergrad	Internship	Student witnessed a traffic related death on a train.	Mental Health
Sri Lanka	December	Graduate	Internship	Sexual Assault	Physical Health
