School of Graduate Studies: Admission requirements for the Combined Jeffrey Skoll B.A.Sc./M.B.A. Program

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

The Committee has the authority to approve admission policies relating to minor changes to individual programs or to divisional practices and policies.

PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

HIGHLIGHTS:

The Rotman School of Management proposes to change the admission process for the Combined Jeffrey Skoll B.A.Sc./M.B.A. Program. Students in the second and third year of the B.A.Sc. program in the Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering would be allowed to apply to the combined program. Specifically:

- a) Students in the second or third year of the B.A.Sc. program in the Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering would be allowed to apply to the combined program;
- b) The required courses for the program: nine 2000-level Management courses and MGT 2050H – Technology/ Management Interface to be revised, with an option to substitute up to two 400-level or higher Engineering courses for 2000-level Management courses.

The purpose of the proposed change in language in the SGS Calendar is to accurately reflect the current practice and understanding between the Faculty of Applied Science & Engineering and the Rotman School for the BASc/MBA Program.

The proposal was approved by the Council of the School of Graduate Studies on February 21, 2006.

It is recommended that the Committee on Academic Policy and Programs approve:

THAT the Rotman School of Management change the admission and program requirements of the Combined Jeffrey Skoll B.A.Sc./M.B.A. Program, commencing September, 2006, as above.
