Faculty of Arts & Science, St. George Campus: Major Calendar Changes 2007-2008.

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

HIGHLIGHTS:

The Faculty of Arts & Science, St. George Campus, is proposing a number of new undergraduate programs and program deletions for the calendar year 2007-08. Information regarding the new programs, academic rationale, fit with academic plan and the expected learning outcomes are included in the attached documentation.

The program additions and deletions were approved by the Faculty's Humanities, Social Sciences, and Sciences Curriculum Committees at their meetings of November 7, 8, 9, 14 and 15, 2006 respectively and by the Arts and Science Faculty Council on December 4, 2006. The programs have been developed in consultation with appropriate partners and cognate departments in the University and have been reviewed by the tri-campus decanal committee.
