University of Toronto at Scarborough: Major Calendar Changes 2008-2009.

JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

The Committee has authority for approval of changes to curriculum within established degree programs that can be accomplished with existing resources and are not major, as in specialist, major and minor programs in arts and science.

HIGHLIGHTS:

The University of Toronto at Scarborough is proposing a new undergraduate program of study and major changes to existing programs for the calendar year 2008-09. Information regarding the new program of study and proposed changes, academic rationale, fit with academic plan and the expected learning outcomes are included in the attached documentation. There are no program deletions proposed.

New Program of study:

Specialist Program in Quantitative Analysis

Major Program Changes

A non-co-operative version of the existing Specialist (Co-operative) Program in Arts Management
A Curatorial Studies stream of the existing Specialist Program in Art and Culture.

The program changes were approved by the U of T Scarborough Academic Committee on December 4, 2007. The programs have been developed in consultation with appropriate partners and cognate departments in the University and have been reviewed by the tri-campus decanal committee.
