ITEM IDENTIFICATION: University of Toronto Scarborough, Major Calendar Changes, 2011-12

#### JURISDICTIONAL INFORMATION:

The Committee has the authority for the approval of changes to curriculum within established degree programs that can be accomplished with existing resources including the addition and deletion of specialist, major and minor programs. More significant changes are recommended to the Academic Board.

#### PREVIOUS ACTION TAKEN:

**HIGHLIGHTS:** The University of Toronto Scarborough is bringing forward a number of program changes including: one new program; a number of major modifications to existing programs for the 2011-12 Calendar; and the deletion of three programs for 2011-12. The proposed changes are summarized below and presented in greater depth in the attached appendix.

#### **Approvals:**

The proposed new program, major and minor modifications, and closures for the 2011-12 calendar were approved by UTSC Academic Committee on 7 December, 2010 (and by the Executive Committee of the UTSC Council on January 6, 2011).

New program proposals, major modifications and program closures also require approval by the Committee on Academic Policy and Programs.
